

The POA and a couple communities have experienced **LETHAL BRONZING on palms**. This is a **contagious disease that slowly kills certain palm trees**, so we wanted to make everyone aware of the problem. If a tree is infected, it must be removed, and nearby susceptible palms should be injected quarterly with antibiotics with the hope of preventing the spread of the disease.

Don't forget to contact the POA before removing any trees; approval is required. If you have these trees on your property, you should have your pest control company check them for signs of the disease:

- Christmas Palm
- Pindo Palm
- Carpentaria Palm
- Coconut Palm
- Canary Island Date Palm
- Edible Date Palm
- Fiji Fan Palm
- Wild Date Palm
- Pygmy Date Palm (Roebelinii)
