Crime Prevention Tips

- Secure your home
 - Lock all doors and windows.
 - Use your alarm system when leaving your home or going to sleep.
 - Install locks on sliding doors and windows.
 - Keep landscape trimmed and exterior lights lit.
 - Consider installing lights on timers inside your home or motion lights around the exterior of your home.
- Secure your vehicle
 - When you park, lock all doors and windows.
 - Do not leave keys and valuable items inside (cell phone, wallet/hand bag, lap top, jewelry etc).
 - If your vehicle has an alarm, use it.
- Secure your valuables
 - Record serial numbers of TVs, computers and other electronics and keep in a safe place.
 - Keep receipts of all valuables.
 - Use a safe in secure location in the home.
 - Consider keeping valuables not regularly used in a safe deposit box.

How to be a S.M.A.R.T NEIGHBOR

What to look for...

- Any unfamiliar person(s) in your neighborhood.
- Anyone walking around houses or vehicles checking doors or looking into windows.
- Unfamiliar vendors working at houses where you know your neighbor is out of town.
- Vehicles driving slowly through neighborhoods that appear to be lost or looking at houses or without lights.

How to be Alert...

- Program security emergency number 627-1600 in your cell phone.
- Take your cell phone with you when you go walking, jogging, riding bicycles etc.
- Take a flashlight with you when you go walking or jogging at night.
- Be aware of your surroundings as you arrive or leave home.
- If you see anyone or anything out of the ordinary, drive around the block and call Security.

When to call Security...

- Anyone or anything suspicious.
- If you hear any unfamiliar or unusual noises.
- If you hear a vehicle or residential alarm.
- If you hear someone screaming for help.
- If you hear a dog barking for a period of time.
- If you see an unfamiliar person sitting in a parked vehicle in your neighborhood.
- If you see an unfamiliar and unattended vehicle(s) parked in your neighborhood for a period of time or at the entrances of PGA National.
- Call anytime... we are here 24/7.
